COVID-19 COMMUNITY COLLABORATION FUND

HCSC provided more than **\$4.1 million in grants to 207 local organizations** to address hunger relief, child care, provider support, senior care and access to care as a part of our COVID-19 Community Collaboration Fund.



IMPROVING ACCESS TO CARE

Responding to high maternal mortality rates, HCSC advocated for a change in federal law allowing state Medicaid programs to extend pregnancy related coverage for a full year after women give birth.
